Who are we?

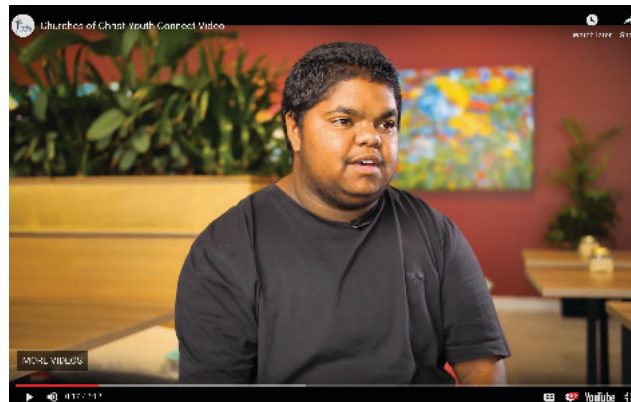

What does home mean for you?

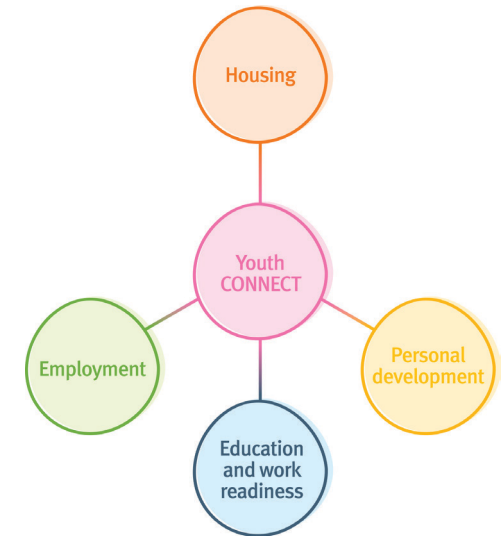
