WHAT IS NAVIGATE?

NAVIGATE is the Churches of Christ Queensland Combined Internship Cohort, bringing together interns from churches across Queensland who are enrolled in internship programs within our movement.

The program is designed to support churches in making disciples and developing young leaders according to their gifts and callings. NAVIGATE offers interns the opportunity to network with peers, receive coaching and guidance outside of their local ministry contexts, and participate in shared internship experiences.

INTERNS




FINANCIAL SUPPORT

THE INTERN



- Commits to the whole
 Navigate program
- Agrees to abide by the Code of Conduct
- Commits to serving a minimum of 8 hours per week

THE CHURCH



- Nominates a leader to facilitate the internship
- Provides the intern a schedule of a minimum of 8 hours per week
- Commits to mentoring and training the intern

THE MENTOR



- Commits to meeting quarterly with the intern
- Agrees to liase with the Navigate coordinator as neccessary

NAVIGATE



- Facilitates the internship cohort
- Communicates with churches and mentors
- Provides support and training as needed for interns and churches

NAVIGATE STREAMS

Year 1 of the NAVIGATE program is open to all interns and focuses on discernment, helping each intern experience and explore God's call on their life.

Our goal is to tailor the experience in such a way that it will work for your intern.

If, by the end of Year 1, an intern feels called to further explore ministry, they may be invited to continue into a second year.

YEAR 1 YEAR 2 TASTE + SEE EXPLORE + EQUIP

Year 2 of the NAVIGATE program offers a deeper dive into leadership, allowing interns to explore ministry as a vocational pathway.

Our goal is to provide a well-rounded ministry experience, with increased opportunities and responsibilities in both local and broader church settings.

Year 2 is open through an application process, and interns must also be enrolled in a study program.



WHAT'S INVOLVED?

Participation in the NAVIGATE Cohort offers a rich variety of experiences, including monthly online gatherings, two retreats and four Navigate Gatherings centered on leadership development, spiritual formation, and training. Interns will also participate in leadership of camps like FUSE and Catapult.

Beyond this, interns will have the opportunity to serve at Churches of Christ Queensland events like combined worship nights and social gatherings, and gain practical experience through billet placements. Interns will also have access to an online platform for networking and resources, further enhancing their growth and development.

ACCREDITATED PATHWAY

We are thrilled to announce Navigate's new partnership with the Australian College of Ministries (ACOM), offering an Accredited Pathway for our 2026 cohort. This partnership provides an exciting opportunity to work towards a formal qualification while engaging in your Navigate internship. In 2026, you will be able to study the undergraduate Certificate of Christian Ministry (1 Year) with ACOM, combining practical ministry experience with accredited learning.

As part of Navigate, you will complete 2 of the 4 units of your certificate through our program, with the remaining 2 units completed directly with ACOM. This Certificate also forms the first four units of the Diploma of Ministry, offering the option to continue your studies in a second year of Navigate should you choose to pursue further learning and growth in ministry.


